



Annual Inspections

The Signal View Staff will be conducting annual inspections on Tuesday, February 14th through Friday, February 17th for units A1 - P240. Inspections will resume on Tuesday, March 14th through Friday, March 17th for units P241 - V484.

- We will be checking for dripping faucets, water leaks and the condition of the apartment for future budgeting purposes.
- The inspections will begin at 9:00 am until 5:00 pm each day. Due to scheduling and unpredictable weather conditions, we cannot give exact dates for each building; therefore, please plan for us to enter your apartment during one of these 4 days.
- It is necessary that we have a copy of each key to each unit. If you have recently changed the lock to your condo, please bring the new key to the office for us to copy. We would like to remind you that it is Signal View's policy that we have a valid key to each unit. If we are unable to enter your condo because we do not have a key, you will be fined for our time.
- A fire protection representative will be with us both months to check the fire extinguishers in each unit.
- If you have any questions, please call the office during our regular business hours. Thank you in advance for your cooperation with our annual inspections.

Proper Pet Care

Per the rental agreement signed between Signal View and Residents regarding pets, these rules must be followed:

Residents will clean up any soil and/or mess inside or outside of the unit created by the pet.

Residents will not allow the pet to roam freely or leave the pet unattended when outside their unit. There will be a fine of \$25.00 per occurrence as well as \$25.00/first occurrence, \$50.00/second occurrence if pet soil is not properly cleaned up.

Permission to keep a pet on the premises may be revoked at any time if the Resident fails to comply with the rules.
