1 Kosher salt

1 tbsp Olive oil, extra-virgin

2 cup Mozzarella

1/2 cup Parmesan

Directions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees On sheet tray, drizzle peppers with olive oil and season with salt/pepper. Spoon sauce into pepper half. Sprinkle with mozzarella/parmesan, top with pepperoni. Bake for 10 - 15 minutes, until peppers are crisp-tender and the cheese is melted.
