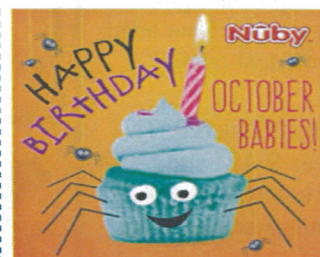

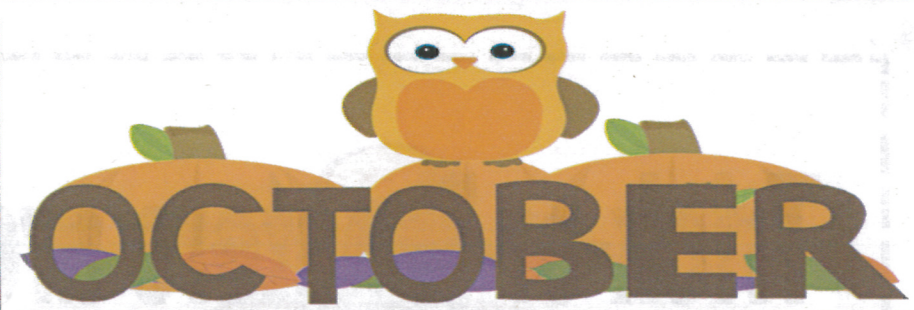

Residents:

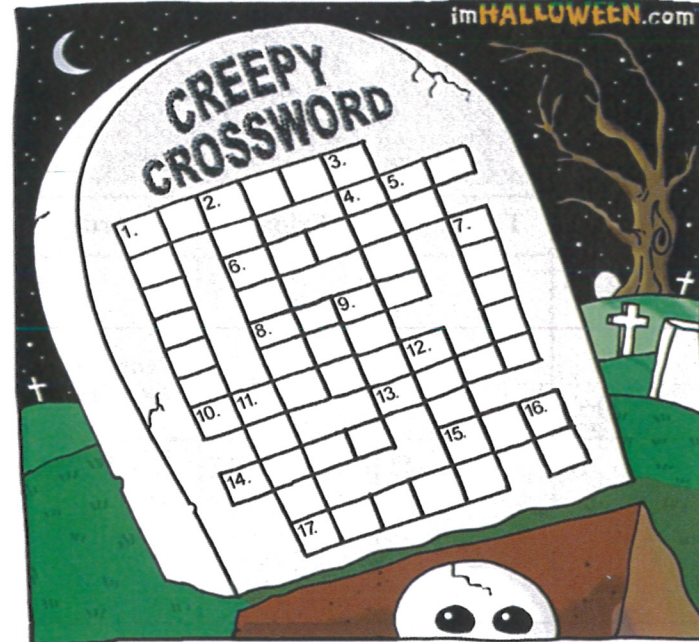
