- 1 cup unsalted
- 1 cup granulated white
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1/2 teaspoon almond
- 1 egg
- ♦ 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- ♦ 3 cups all purpose flour

#### **Directions:**

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- 2. Mix together butter and sugar until smooth, add egg.
- 3. In a separate bowl, mix baking powder, salt, flour. Add this mixture to the wet ingredients. The dough will be stiff, if it gets too tough for your mixture, lay out the dough on the counter, wet your hands and knead by hand.
- 4. Divide into workable batches, roll out and cut (1/4 inch cookies)
- 5. Bake at 350 for 6-8 minutes and enjoy!
